This letter is a response to your request pursuant to the Freedom of Information Law received on April 15, 2018 for the following records:

All agent or agents of the city emails released by the mayor's office in December 2017 as referenced in press accounts on December 27, 2017 (New York Post, https://nypost.com/2017/12/27/why-it-took-so-long-for-de-blasio-to-endorse-clinton/; New York Daily News, http://www.nydailynews.com/opinion/campaign-bill-de-blasio-article-1.3722064).

After conducting a search, the Mayor's Office has identified records responsive to your request under FOIL. Responsive records are attached. Please note that some responsive material has been redacted in part or withheld in its entirety pursuant to Public Officers Law §87(2)(b) and (g). Some materials have been redacted in part pursuant to Public Officers Law §87(2) (b) and (g) based on past Mayor's Office disclosures of schedules. These redactions consist of schedule entries such as personal appointments, job interviews where the individual was not hired, or preliminary notations of meetings that may not have occurred. Your request is now considered complete.

Additionally, attached you will find a table containing the identities of those whose personal email addresses were redacted pursuant to Public Officers Law §87(2)(b), effectively concealing the identities of the senders and/or recipients. Please note that the Mayor's Office is not aware of all identities of email recipients and senders. Those email senders and recipients who could not be identified are marked as "Unknown" on the attached table.
