
How Do I Respond?

Connect residents with their local NCOs

A reminder to call 311 or 911 and that the page is not monitored 24/7, as per the disclaimer.

Don't forget to follow up with your victory lap!



Keys to Success

Engage, Engage, Engage

Double and triple check for spelling and grammar

Create local content

Use the entire command as your "reporters"

PNA - Please No Acronyms! you have room

Utilize the DCSC Staff!

Checklist

- Email your lists to tell them about page
- Use handouts and posters
- Open "events" for sector meetings
- Create welcome video
- Inform detective squad
- Keep the page active!

Removing Users


Only content that violates the New York City Social Media policy should be removed from the page.

Commands may utilize the "hide" feature rather than the "delete" feature to remove content from the page.

In a case that an account operator would like to remove content that does not violate any of the above, they should confer with DCSC staff.

Banning users is prohibited; specific cases should be brought to the attention of DCSC and DC Legal Bureau.
