Dear Jay Cassano:

This letter is a response to your request pursuant to the Freedom of Information Law received on March 03, 2017 for the following records:

All records of communications mentioning Ramarley Graham; All records of communications mentioning NYPD officer Richard Haste.

Public Officers Law §89(3)(a) requires that a request "reasonably" describe the records sought. The initial search for your requests resulted in approximately 82,000 potentially responsive records. On March 8, 2017, you narrowed your request and the subsequent search resulted in approximately 22,166 potentially responsive records.

The Mayor's Office attempted to contact you on October 26, 2017, November 16, 2017, November 22, 2017, and December 11, 2017 in order to further narrow your request. Since we were unable to do so, your request is denied as unreasonably burdensome pursuant to Public Officers law §89(3)(a).
